N. SANTA MONICA BOULEVARD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Side Street Closures | Beginning May 21, 2018

Dear Residents, Businesses and Community Members,

Beginning May 21, 2018 for approximately four weeks, the contractor will conduct the final grinding, paving and striping operations along N. Santa Monica Boulevard which will necessitate the closure of the side streets leading to and from N. Santa Monica Boulevard to guarantee the best final finish of the street. The work will begin in the west and travel east in segments, so that not all side streets are closed at once.

Side streets:

Closed one day for grinding

Closed one night for paving

Closed another night for striping

Asphalt Grinding:

Western City Limits and Alpine Drive

May 21 through May 25

M-F 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

- Intersection of N. Santa Monica Blvd and Wilshire closed 12 a.m. - 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction within the work segment
- Side street access will be closed

Asphalt Paving:

West and East City Limits

May 24 through June 1

M-F 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

- Intersection of N. Santa Monica Blvd and Wilshire closed 12 a.m. - 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction within the work segment
- Side street access will be closed

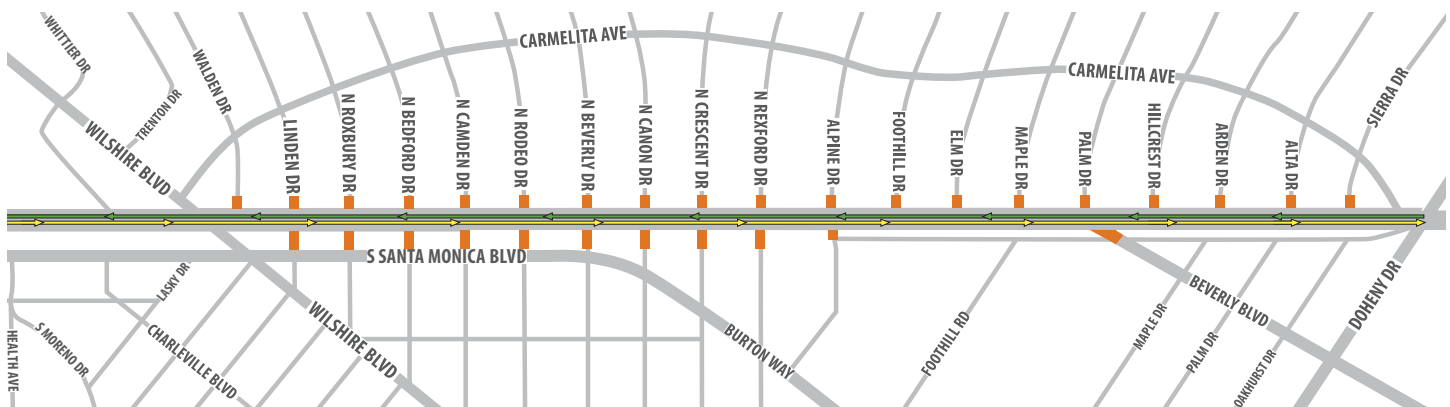
Asphalt Striping:

West and East City Limits

June 4 through June 15

M-F 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

- One lane in each direction within the work segment
- Side street access will be closed



What to Expect:

- Construction equipment and light vibration
- Intermittent lane closures with proper traffic control

Please be assured that the City and contractor are taking a proactive approach to mitigating noise as much as possible while still conducting the necessary work.
