BEVERLY HILLS, California (April 22) – The Board of Trustees of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce Leadership Political Action Committee (PAC) has endorsed Lester Friedman and Robert Wunderlich for Beverly Hills City Council and Howard Fisher for Beverly Hills City Treasurer for the upcoming June 7, 2022 election.
