

The Beverly Wilshire, A Four Seasons Hotel Opened in 1928. Chamber member since 1945.

Located on the famous intersection of Wilshire Blvd, and Rodeo Dr. - the Beverly Wilshire Hotel is an iconic landmark in the heart of Beverly Hills. Showcasing Italian Renaissance architectural design - it is recognized as the setting for many television shows and films - including the film Pretty Woman and ty shows such as Entourage - the hotel is an homage to Beverly Hills' longstanding history.

The Beverly Hilton Hotel Opened in 1955. Chamber member since at least 1955. Home to the Golden Globes since 1961

The Beverly Hilton is known for hosting many awards shows, charity benefits, and entertainment and motion picture industry events. It is particularly famous as the venue of the annual Golden Globe Awards ceremony, which has been held there since 1961. The hotel has also been the site of many iconic moments in Hollywood history, such as the wedding of actors Richard Burton and Elizabeth Taylor in 1964, and the press conference of John F. Kennedy during the 1960 presidential campaign. The hotel has recently undergone a renovation that has modernized its rooms and facilities, while maintaining its classic elegance and glamour. The Beverly Hilton is a landmark of Los Angeles' hospitality scene and a symbol of the city's celebrity culture.

The Beverly Hills Hotel Established 1912. Chamber member since at least 1955.

Referred to affectionately as the "Pink Palace" - The Beverly Hills Hotel has been all sorts of famous people's home away from home Anyone who is anyone in the entertainment industry has stayed, eaten, or partied there. It has even drawn in the likes of the British Royal Family. Many people assume that the city of Beverly Hills grew, and then the ritzy hotel was built to suit the city and its glamorous people. The opposite is actually true. The hotel was constructed before the city in order to draw in people coming to the area to look at buying and developing the land.

Greater LA Realtors Association Established & Chamber member since 1963.

The term "realtor" is a professional trade association designation and symbolizes the distinction between the average real estate licensee and a member of organized real estate. Realtors agree to adopt and abide by the National Association of Realtors Code of Ethics. The GLAR represents over 13.600 Realtors and affiliate members in the cities of Beverly Hills. Culver City. Los Angeles. Santa Monica, West Hollywood, and unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County. Realtor members set themselves apart and above thousands of other real estate licensees who are outside of organized real estate and who do not benefit from the strong positioning of a leadership organization. The GLAR provides a wide array of benefits and services designed to assist members in pursuing the real estate profession with fairness, integrity and competence. In addition, the GLAR provides legislative advocacy to ensure a favorable climate for the real estate industry.



Cedars-Sinai Medical Center Opened in 1902. Chamber member since 1993.

Cedars-Sinai Medical Center is a nonprofit, teaching hospital and multi-specialty academic health science center. Part of the Cedars-Sinai Health System, the hospital has a staff of over 2,000 physicians and 10,000 employees, supported by a team of thousands of volunteers and more than 40 community groups. As of 2022-23, U.S. News & World Report ranked Cedars-Sinai among the top performing hospitals in the western United States. Cedars-Sinai is a teaching hospital affiliate of David Geffen School of Medicine at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), which was ranked in the top 20 on the U.S. News 2023 Best Medical Schools: Research.

Mickey Fine Pharmacy & Grill Opened in 1962. Chamber member since 1964.

A Beverly Hills landmark. Mickey Fine is the only original pharmacy with a soda fountain in all of Los Angeles. They have been serving the residents of Los Angeles since 1962. Both a full service pharmacy and dine-in restaurant with a counter and soda fountain (it is the only remaining pharmacy in Southern California with a soda fountain) - Mickey Fine provides an experience that most pharmacies today are not able to offer.



GEARYS Beverly Hills Opened in 1930. Chamber member since 1998.

GEARYS Beverly Hills first opened its doors in 1930, as a small neighborhood store where hardware and dinnerware were found only aisles apart. It was named after its founder. H.L. Geary. a former President of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce. In 1953, H.L. Geary retired, selling GEARYS Beverly Hills to the Meyer family and their transformative vision. Fred, along with his wife Ruth, solidified GEARYS position as a true landmark in the city of Beverly Hills. Into the 1970s. Fred and Ruth's son Bruce partnered with world-class names like Baccarat and Lalique to establish GEARYS Beverly Hills as one of the country's preeminent destinations for luxury dinnerware and gifts. A couple decades later - Ruth and Fred's grandson Thomas Blumenthal at the helm as CEO. GEARYS Beverly Hills charted a thriving partnership with Rolex. Having inherited the family passion for bringing the GEARYS tradition to the world, Thomas followed up GEARYS Beverly Hills on Rodeo with a much celebrated Rolex boutique at the Westfield Century City Mall in 2009. A landmark in Beyerly Hills and beyond. GEARYS Beverly Hills resonates with the traditions that define Beverly Hills. For nearly a century. GEARYS has flourished because of its incredible ability to expertly define luxury according to the times.

What is a Chamber of Commerce?

THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IS THE BUSINESS CON MUNITY WORKING TOGETHER. It is the central agency that corrals the forces of the community for its improvement and development - in business, in industry, and in the professions. Together, the chamber does what no one person in do hy himself

From this early beginning the total number has blossomed to 4,000, with the number of chamhers in the United States on a constant incline.

The board also supervises several ommittees which are set up to handle specific projects The paid head of the chamber is the manager, who has a naid staff under him. The size of the staff depends on the demands and needs of the community and the amount of work that the chamber carries out. As a matter of fact, in some smaller communities the manager may be a voluntary r part-time employee. His title will vary in different communities from "manager" to "general manager" or "executive secretary," or others.

What does it do?

THE CHAMBER'S JOB IS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT. This includes development of industry and trade, handling of civic activities, publicity and public relations for the community, and many others. The variety and scope of activities is virtually unlimited, depending on the needs of the community and the desire and ability of the chamber to arry them out. The chamber may aim to increase commun ty payrolls, improve the buying power of its citizens, attract more customers to the trading and retail area solve city zoning problems, improve the parking situation

The United States Census of 1920 counted 674 people as residents of the newly incorporated City of Beverly Hills. Known as "Midway between Los Angeles and the Sea," the new community, while steeped in pride and optimism, faced tough challenges in those early years.

The real estate boom of the early 1920s created a series of issues for residents, and new businesses needed to support the growing population. On May 1, 1923, sixty community members gathered in the first meeting of what would quickly become the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce. On June 11, 1923, an organization and a motion to incorporate a Chamber of Commerce into the City of Beverly Hills were approved. One hundred years later, the deep partnership between the Chamber of Commerce and the City of Beverly Hills continues to flourish. The close collaboration gives Chamber members a direct line of contact to all City Hall resources—invaluable when it comes to things like permits, parking, and even neighborhood ribbon-cuttings by the Mayor.

We cherish our partnership with City Hall. Business in Beverly Hills would not be as vibrant without the passionate support of our elected officials and City staffers alike.







Todd Johnson is the President and CEO of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce. He's been at the helm of the Chamber for over 12 vears.

Where are you from originally?

Wellsboro, Pennsylvania.

When did you start working at the Chamber?

While I was in the restaurant world. I was involved with the Chamber for 12 years on their Board, and I served as Chair of the Board in 2010. I took over as President & CEO of the Chamber in 2015. Being on both sides. I feel that I have a unique perspective on both sides of the table-being a member and part of the staff.

What were you doing before you started working at the Chamber?

I was in the restaurant business for 28 years, and 17 years was with Lawry's. I was the General Manager for the Beverly Hills location, then served as Regional Manager for six and a half years.

Favorite thing about your job:


